

## **INTERNAL REGULATIONS**

### **CALL FOR PROJECTS “The Agitator”**

**University of South Brittany Foundation (Fondation Université Bretagne Sud)**

#### **Article 1: General Presentation of the Call for Projects**

As part of its strategic plan, the University of South Brittany Foundation (UBS Foundation) has established a call for projects aimed at students enrolled at UBS and at students from other universities within the EMERGE alliance.

This initiative aims to support, encourage, and stimulate both individual and collective student initiatives (associative, entrepreneurial projects, challenges, etc.). The call for projects also seeks to promote interaction between students and socio-economic stakeholders in their region.

#### **Article 2: Objectives**

Projects submitted under this call must implement concrete actions primarily in areas related to sustainable development and solidarity.

Special attention will be given to projects that demonstrate a desire to “build links ” between people.

#### **Article 3: Eligible Applicants**

The call for projects is open to all students of the University of South Brittany enrolled in its various faculties:

- Faculty of Law and Political Science
- IAE Bretagne Sud (School of Business Management)
- Faculty of Science and Engineering
- Faculty of Arts, Languages, Humanities and Social Sciences
- University Institutes of Technology (IUT) of Vannes and Lorient
- National Graduate School of Engineering of South Brittany (ENSIBS)

It is also open to PhD students enrolled in the doctoral school of the University of South Brittany, as well as to students from other universities that are part of the **EMERGE alliance**.

Students who applied to “the Agitator” in previous editions (2021–2022, 2022–2023, 2023–2024, and 2024–2025) may reapply provided that their project has evolved.

## **Article 4: Application and Selection Criteria**

Projects may be either individual (submitted by one student) or collective (submitted by several students).

Applicants agree to uphold ethical values such as respect, integrity, and transparency throughout the submission process. Applications must be submitted online via the application form, along with the two appendices to this regulation (budget and image rights authorization), in accordance with the timeline defined in Article 6.

### **Selection criteria:**

- Societal and innovative or exemplary interest of the project, evaluated according to the themes defined in Article 2,
- Or societal and innovative or exemplary interest of the project, evaluated according to the values promoted by the University of South Brittany and its Foundation for projects with an open theme,
- Technical and financial feasibility,
- Active communication and promotion efforts,
- Impact on the territory of the University of South Brittany (the area of your campus, the Morbihan region, or Brittany as a whole) and/or on the territory of EMERGE alliance universities.

The winners will be selected by a jury composed of the President of the University of South Brittany Foundation and members of the “The Agitator” steering committee (COPIL) of the Foundation.

## **Article 5: Awards**

Three projects may be rewarded as follows:

- Support in project engineering,
- Assistance in promoting and increasing the visibility of the project,
- Financial support up to a maximum of **€1,500**.

## **Article 6 : Timeline**

- **Opening of the call for projects:** Wednesday, November 12, 2025
- **Application deadline :** Sunday, February 22, 2026
- **In-person jury meeting:** Thursday, March 5, 2026
- **Announcement of results / award ceremony:** Wednesday, March 11, 2026

The University of South Brittany Foundation reserves the right to modify this calendar; applicants will be informed of any changes.

### **Article 7: Communication and Publication of Projects**

The Foundation reserves the right to communicate about the various projects within the university and in the press. An image rights authorization form must be completed (see appendix).

### **Article 8: Miscellaneous**

Project leaders may contact the administrative and financial coordinator of the call for projects ([fondation@univ-ubs.fr](mailto:fondation@univ-ubs.fr)) for additional information, advice, or feedback regarding their project.

For specific aspects of project development (marketing, budgeting, etc.), a mentor may be assigned.
