To whom it may concern:

I write to manifest my interest in realizing a period of visiting fellowship at the University Bretagne Sud.

I am a Social Anthropologist specializing in tourism and travel culture. I received my PhD (2013) in Social and Cultural Anthropology at the University of Barcelona, where I currently work as an Assistant Professor (tenure-eligible position).

My academic training and research interests revolve around the anthropological study of tourism. My approach has moved around two axes: on the one hand, the interplay between cultural meanings and social dynamics in the tourist encounter; on the other hand, the analysis of the socio-cultural imaginaries of tourists and travellers, a perspective still little explored in social sciences. Following this latter strand, in 2016 I have started researching digital nomadism, considering its disruptive potential as a unique form of travel lifestyle blending work and leisure.

My research on digital nomads and lifestyle mobilities uses an innovative mobile virtual ethnography approach blending conventional in-depth multi-local fieldwork in Spain and Thailand with ongoing online research. Since 2016, I have immersed myself in four digital nomads' groups on Facebook, conducting video-interviews and non-intrusive participant observation, formalised through a netnographic research protocol.

I have published articles and book chapters in multiple languages, featured in: Journal of Tourism and Cultural Change, International Journal of Heritage Studies, Information Technologies and Tourism, Anthropologies et Sociétés, Mobilities, Mobility Humanities, Social Anthropology, Tourism Geographies.

Previously, I have also authored the monograph "Zafimaniry: l'invention d'une tribu. Art ethnique, patrimoine immatériel et tourisme" (L'Harmattan, 2017).

I was the coordinator of ANTHROMOB (2018-2022), the EASA (European Association Social Anthropology) network of Anthropology and Mobility.

Through ANTHROMOB I have fostered a number of academic activities, including a workshop titled: *Mobility and the Future of Work* (Barcelona, 2019) and *MoMO*, a quarterly series of online lectures featuring mobility experts. I have also served in the Editorial Board of *Quaderns*, journal of the Catalan Institute of Anthropology, and I am currently member of the Editorial board of *International Journal of Tourism Anthropology* (IJTA) and of the Editorial committee of *Worlds in Motion*, a transdisciplinary book series about mobility edited by Berghahn Books.

Lettre d'invitation au professeur Fabiola Mancinelli

Fabiola Mancinelli, professeur à *Universitat de Barcelona*, est anthropologue. Elle a pour objet de recherche, depuis son doctorat, les mobilités contemporaines. Ces dernières années elle a consacré son travail à l'étude des nomades numériques et à leurs pratiques sociales. Dans un de ses récents articles¹, F.Mancinelli développe une présentation particulièrement signifiante des nomades numériques dans le cadre des théories de la mobilité et de l'individualisation du mode de vie. Elle met ainsi en contraste les imaginaires socioculturels de la (l'im)mobilité des nomades numériques avec les stratégies économiques spécifiques qu'ils utilisent pour maintenir la continuité de leur mobilité, y compris le géoarbitrage et la marchandisation du capital réseau. Elle questionne aussi leurs adaptations aux contraintes de libre circulation (obtention visa, réalités institutionnelles nationales).

Plusieurs chercheurs de l'UBS² travaillent également sur cette thématique en s'intéressant notamment aux tiers-lieux fréquentés par les nomades numériques. La recherche sur le sujet est en plein essor et notre équipe est précurseuse en France. Il s'agit aujourd'hui de l'élargir afin de pouvoir prétendre à l'obtention de programmes d'envergure nationale et internationale. C'est pourquoi nous construisons actuellement une réponse pour l'AAPG 2024 de l'ANR. A ce titre, nous organisons un séminaire le 10 et 11 octobre 2023. Il se déroulera à Lorient et en visio avec les chercheurs ayant d'ores et déjà rejoint le consortium en train de se constituer.

F.Mancinelli, en étant accueillie à l'UBS dans la semaine du 9 octobre 2023, pourrait dès lors participer à ce séminaire de recherche ANR. Son intégration au consortium constituerait un atout majeur pour la réussite du projet. Il est en effet souhaitable qu'elle intègre, en tant qu'anthropologue, l'équipe pluridisciplinaire de chercheurs qui rassemble d'ores et déjà des collègues d'information-communication, des géographes, des économistes et des juristes.

De plus, par les sujets qu'elle travaille, Fabiola Mancinelli pourrait intervenir pour quelques heures de cours auprès des étudiants du Master Aménagement et Urbanismes des Territoires littoraux ainsi qu'auprès des étudiants d'histoire-géographie.
